



## Foundation Scholarships Eligibility Requirements

Many scholarships are available through the Rhodes State College Foundation and through external sources for students. Most applications for scholarships are available early spring and provide funding for the upcoming academic year. Students can now apply for foundation scholarships online at <http://foundationscholarships.rhodesstate.edu/stars> **All scholarships administered have minimum standards for the student to receive funding and require a written essay and two letters of recommendation.** A recommendation form is available online at [www.rhodesstate.edu](http://www.rhodesstate.edu). Most awards are divided into equal parts over three academic quarters (Fall, Winter, and Spring) unless specified differently at the time of the award. Each quarter's award is dependent on the academic success of the student during the prior quarter and is subject to the Academic Standards Policy. **All applicants must submit a FAFSA, available online at [www.FAFSA.ed.gov](http://www.FAFSA.ed.gov), to be eligible for scholarships.** Please see the requirements listed below for foundation scholarships. Other criteria may apply.

Scholarship	Eligibility Requirements
<b>Allied Health Major</b>	
Anigbogu Godwin Rovner Respiratory Care Scholarship	Current or incoming students who are enrolled in the Respiratory Care Major or Sleep Certificate program may apply. Students must have a 2.5 GPA or above and demonstrate financial need to apply.
Borra Family Foundation Scholarship	Full-time students who must have and maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA and who have demonstrated financial need.
Dr. Robert D. Brunk Scholarship	Students with a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA who must answer an essay question regarding dental hygiene practice and complete a brief biographical sketch of the applicant. A personal interview may also be required.
Elizabeth Enneking Memorial Scholarship	Full-time students who have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA and have completed or are completing their first year of study in RES, OTA or PTA program. Must have at least one recommendation from a clinical site supervisor or faculty member and an interest in working with young children with special needs.
Frank and Shirley Hill Scholarship	First year, full-time students who have and are able to maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.
Respiratory Care Scholarship	Full or part-time students who have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA and who are completing the first year of the Respiratory Care Program.
Terri Hill-Kaufman Memorial Scholarship	Students who have successfully completed at least 12 credit hours with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and who have the ability to be a successful student at Rhodes State College.
Thomas R. and Gloria P. Leech Scholarship	Students enrolled in a Health major who demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA, which must be maintained. Preference is given to residents of Allen and Hardin counties.
Thomas and Linda Leshner Dental Hygiene Scholarship	Full-time students who have completed 19 credit hours in the Dental Hygiene Program with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. The student must be qualified and accepted into the Dental Hygiene program for Clinicals this fall.

<b>Nursing</b>	
Avis Hardin Smith Memorial Scholarship	Students enrolled in the Nursing program at Rhodes State College. Preference is given to graduates of Perry or Waynesfield-Goshen school district, then to Allen, Auglaize, or Hardin county residents. A 2.0 cumulative GPA is required.
Elizabeth Enneking Memorial Scholarship	Full-time students who have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA and have completed or are completing their first year of study in the Nursing Program. Must have at least one recommendation from a clinical site supervisor or faculty member and an interest in working with young children with special needs.
Margaret Durbin Robenalt Memorial Scholarship	Nursing students who have completed one year of training in the program with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. Two recommendations from members of the Nursing faculty are required.
Nursing Scholarship	Second-year Nursing students who have and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA and demonstrate financial need.
Terri Hill-Kaufman Memorial Scholarship	Students who have successfully completed at least 12 credit hours with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and have the ability to be a success at Rhodes State College.
Thomas R. and Gloria P. Leech Scholarship	Students who are enrolled in a Health major who demonstrate financial need and have and maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to residents of Allen and Hardin counties.
<b>Business and Public Service Majors</b>	
Elizabeth Enneking Memorial Scholarship	Full-time students who have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA and have completed or are completing their first year of study in the Early Childhood Development program. Must have at least one recommendation from a clinical site supervisor or faculty member and an interest in working with young children with special needs.
Gary Weaver Public Service Scholarship	Full-time students enrolled in ECE, HUM, or LAW who have completed or are completing 45 credit hours toward his/her major and have verified financial need. A recommendation from the Chair of his/her department is required. A 2.0 cumulative GPA is required.
John J. and Martha M. Hudson Scholarship	Full-time students who live in Allen County and are majoring in a Business program or a program in the Division of Information Technology and Engineering Technology at Rhodes State College. Students are required to have a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
Margot and Robert B. Keller Public Service Scholarship	Any full-time student majoring in ECE, HUM, or LAW who have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. A recommendation from a faculty member of his/her department or a high school advisor is required.
Matthew C. Terrill Memorial Scholarship	Students must have enrolled in and completed a minimum of 12 credit hours at Rhodes State College and have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to graduates of Ridgemoor High School, then to residents of Hardin or Logan counties.
Rakowsky Scholarship	Full-time students with a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA. Students must be majoring in Engineering Technologies or Business
<b>Information Technology and Engineering Technology</b>	
Hardin County Engineering Technology Scholarship	Full-time Engineering Technology students who demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to students of Hardin County.
John J. and Martha M. Hudson	Full-time students in Allen County majoring in a Business program or a program in the Division of Information Technology and Engineering Technology. A cumulative 2.0 GPA is required.

Marilyn Shaffer Office Administration Scholarship	Full or part-time students majoring in Office Administration who have completed at least 25 credit hours with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. A recommendation from an Office Administration faculty member is required.
Rakowsky Scholarship	Full-time students majoring in Engineering Technologies or Business with at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
Roger Jones Concrete Technology Scholarship	Full or part-time students registered in Civil Engineering in the Concrete Technologies program with a minimum 2.5 GPA.
West Central Ohio Manufacturing Consortium Scholarship	Full and part-time students interested in obtaining an intermediate or advanced certification in manufacturing career pathways and/or a degree in Engineering Technology/Information Information or a related field. Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.
<b>All Majors</b>	
David and Marie Steiner Scholarship	Full-time students with unmet financial need who have a 3.0 GPA in his/her program of study. Preference is given to students of Allen County.
Distance Education Scholarship	Full or part-time students who have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA and work at least 20 hours per week. The students must have or be in the process of completing 45 credit hours with 25% of those hours being in a distance education format.
Dr. Wilfred Ellis Multicultural Scholarship	Students of multicultural backgrounds who demonstrate financial need and are able to maintain at least a 2.5 GPA. Preference is given to students of Allen County.
Gilbert Scholarship	Any full or part-time student, age 21 years or older, demonstrating financial need and are self supporting as defined by the Rhodes State College Financial Aid Office. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is also required.
Jack and Margaret Howell Putnam County Scholarship	Full-time students who must maintain at least a 2.9 cumulative GPA. Preference is given to residents and high school graduates of Putnam County.
James J. Countryman Scholarship	Any full-time student who has demonstrated financial need and does not qualify for other forms of financial aid. Student must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA.
Lima Elks Fifty Four Scholarship Fund	Any full or part-time student with a demonstrated financial need and a minimum 2.0 GPA is eligible to apply.
McClain/Marshall Scholarship	Female students age 30 or over who demonstrate financial need with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference is given to graduates of Ada High School then to residents of Hardin County.
Kito Christian Shane McCurdy Scholarship	Any full or part-time student who demonstrates financial need with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Preference is given to an Allen County resident who is a first-time student at Rhodes State College, including PSEOP.
Memorial Scholarship	Any full or part-time student who has earned at least 24 credit hours at Rhodes State College. A minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA is required.
Norman and Margaret Browning Scholarship	Students who demonstrate unmet financial need and have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Preference is given to students of Allen County.
Outstanding Alumni Scholarship	Full or part-time students who have demonstrated financial need. Must maintain at least a 3.0 GPA in his/her program of study and be enrolled in the same program as the prior years' award recipient.
George B. Quatman Scholarship	Any full-time student with a minimum cumulative 3.2 GPA and an ACT score of 22.
